

OVERVIEW

With return of 0.71%, August was notable for Global Profix USD, as it summarized the one-year cycle since the inception of the Fund. Overall, the performance of the Fund was quite successful, returning 12.7% since inception. Net assets of the Fund almost doubled during the period, while number of securities in the portfolio increased to 11 (from 8 a year ago). Current average YTM stands at 6.63% with average maturity of assets held at 1.12 years.

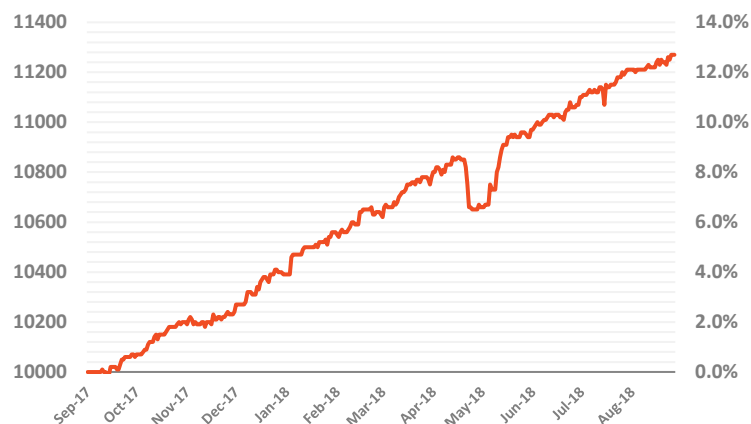

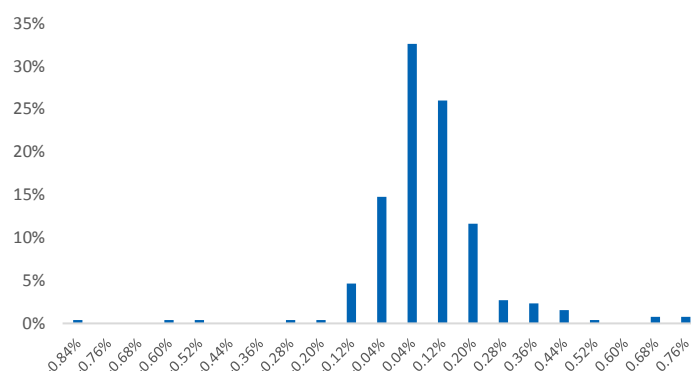

The Fund's average borrowing rate was 2.73% for USD and 6.50% for AMD during the month.

Average yield was 6.26% for USD denominated bonds and 12.24% for AMD bonds. The portfolio's financial leverage equaled to 3 by the end of the month. Average maturity of the holdings of the Fund rounded to 1.12 years.

USD denominated corporate bonds 90.8% of the portfolio. Allocation to corporate bonds denominated in AMD amounts to 7.7% and cash comprises 1.5% of the portfolio.
